



## Safe at Home Program

### Safe at Home Clean Up and Re-Secure Program (CRP)

#### Eligibility Criteria and Service Elements

The Clean Up and Re-secure program is designed to assist victims of crime financially to an amount of \$400 to clean up their property following a violent crime or re-secure their property following an unlawful entry.

The program will complement existing services to assist victims and potential victims of property and violent crime in the Northern Territory to feel safe in their place of residence and have their residence forensically cleaned following a violent crime.

Clean Up and Re-secure program provides Territorians with assistance to re-secure their residence following an unlawful entry or to clean up bodily fluids following a violent crime.

Clean-up and Re-secure (CRP) operates on a 24 hour basis.

The **Clean-up** element of the CRP allows Victims of Crime NT (VOCNT) to provide forensic cleaning of a residence following an assault or homicide in which body fluids have been dispersed at the crime scene.

Eligibility criteria:

- Crime of violence requiring a forensic clean-up of bodily fluids

This service is available Territory wide dependent on service providers and can be accessed by Territorians through referral or by contacting the 1800 672 242.

The Resecure element of the CRP will ensure that victims will have their home re-secured as soon as possible and they are connected to support services that will assist in dealing with the emotional stress such crimes create.

Where relevant CRP clients will also be able to be assisted by the Security Improvement component of the CRP is available to all eligible Territorians.

Eligibility Criteria;

- Must be a primary residence (excludes garages, sheds, gates etc.)
- Must be reported to police and the applicant must be cooperating with the police investigation.

The CRP program is **not** available to non-residential properties such as, shops, business, churches etc.
